Making sure you do not ship cartridges which we can not accept, helps avoid shipping and handling costs and time which help us control costs. This handy picture guide has been designed to help you identify cartridges which we do not accept. **Please review it carefully when you send ink jet cartridges to our program. Note: This listing is a guide to assist you in checking the ink jet cartridges you send us. This list identifies only the most common cartridges we do not accept. We do not accept any damaged cartridges.** This listing is subject to change without notice based on market conditions and demand for ink jet empties.



**Special Note About HP 51641A**  
There are several cartridges which look like this one. The part numbers appear on the front label. When sending this style cartridge; please carefully check the label. We do not accept cartridges labeled - 51641A or 41A. We do accept cartridges labeled - C6578 or 78, C1823 or 23 and C6625 or 17.

**Helpful Hint:** If the body of the cartridge you receive is clear, gray or white - it can not be recycled and should not be sent to our program.

### Our Program Does Not Accept Any Epson Cartridges or Cartridges Made for Epson Printers

We do not accept any cartridges which are "ink tanks" only and which do not have electronic circuitry. These cartridges can not be economically recycled. **This includes all Epson cartridges and any cartridges made for Epson printers manufactured by other companies.** It also includes some Canon, Apple and Brother cartridges - some of which are pictured above. Additional pictures of Epson cartridges appear on the back of this page. These photos are only a few of the many Epson cartridges which we are unable to accept.

If you see screws, plugs or other evidence of drilling on a cartridge, please do not send it to us. These cartridges, once drilled, can not be successfully recycled again. Our program does not pay for cartridges which have been previously recycled, drilled or damaged.
